Names of the deceased are listed alphabetically. Newspaper citations are given for the *Deseret News*, *Salt Lake Tribune*, *Salt Lake Herald*, *Salt Lake Telegram*, and occasionally, the *Millennial Star* and the *Journal History of the Church*.

Names of notable people are listed in the "Name" section, while the obituary citations are listed, depending on the year, under "Obituaries" or "Deaths." Each year is a different roll of film, so knowing the year of death is helpful.
