





# Biography Files


Thousands of documents and photos are filed by person in this room.

The beautiful artwork of J.T. Harwood and Paul Salisbury are part of the Lehi High School art collection made up of mainly Lehi artists, many now famous.




# Historical Files and Oversized Items

We have a complete collection of Lehi newspapers dating back to 1914.






# Yearbook Room


This room boasts Lehi High School Yearbooks dating back to 1913 as well as other area yearbooks and a vast collection of Sego Lily Elementary photos and documents.
