Please accept this email as formal appeal of a GRAMA request denied by the Salt Lake County Chief Administrative Officer of Appeals.

Introduction

I became aware that a complainant to the Salt Lake County Department of Planning and Development Services, Division of Code Enforcement, Code Enforcement File #B18473 had trespassed on my property to obtain photos submitted with a complaint. The complaint was investigated and no code infraction was found. A copy of the complaint was redacted as to the name of the complainant.

This was distressing because of

1. A large and ongoing problem for trespass in Cardiff Fork affecting not only my properties, but many of my neighbors as well.
2. Many No Trespassing signs have been posted.
3. Ongoing vandalism of Property including No Trespassing signs.
4. Several individuals have received Notice against entry by personal communication as per Utah Code 76-6-206 (2) (b) (i).

July 26, 2018: GRAMA Request

Desiring to pursue civil remedies and/or to give proper personal notice against entry I filed a GRAMA request to obtain the identity of the trespasser. On July 26, I sent in the GRAMA request for an unredacted copy of the complaint.

August 8, 2018: GRAMA Response

Brittany Allen, Associate Division Director, Salt Lake County Planning & Development Services Division denied my GRAMA request and provided information for an appeal.

August 9, 2018: Appeal

I appealed the denial to Karen Hale, Deputy Mayor Community & External Affairs, Salt Lake County.

August 22, 2018: Appeal Response

Ms. Hale denied my appeal and provided information for an appeal of her decision.

September 5, 2018: Second Level Appeal

I appealed Ms. Hales decision to the Chief Administrative Officer for Appeals in writing as required.

September 11, 2018: Second Level Appeal Response

On October 4th, 2018 I received an email with the response to my Second Level Appeal dated September 11, 2018. The response again denied my request, and was provided by Megan Hillyard, Director of the Salt Lake County Department of Administrative Services. She indicated that the next level would be the State Records Committee.

October 4, 2018: State Records Committee Appeal

It appears that this issue has exhausted all lower level administrative remedies, and is now ripe for the State Records Committee. The county has indicated that they would be willing to supply my requested information under the direction of an Administrative Law Judge. This would be in the interests of justice because withholding the identity of a criminal results in manifest injustice to me as a property owner. I am unable to avail myself of civil remedies to the crime committed against me. It is NOT just to harbor a criminal, which is the net effect of the actions of the County. Furthermore, I am unable to provide notice against future entry by personal communication as per Utah Code 76-6-206 (2) (b) (i), which will have the net result of propagating trespass.

Therefore, I respectfully request and demand that Salt Lake County be ordered to disclose the information sought, namely an un-redacted copy of the complaint in Salt Lake County Department of Planning and Development Services, Division of Code Enforcement, Code Enforcement File #B18473, and the identity of the complainant which they indicate they know.
