Second - appealed to Eric Houston (mayor) as Panguitch City Manager directed.

Eric Houston (Mayor) denied and directed to go to the Record Committee.

Over simplification about this record - for you, ombudswoman (Rosemary) and the record committee -

(1) Utah law - no relatives allowed to be hired, work in same department, under supervision of relative.

(2) Relatives are defined as - wife, husband, son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, cousins, brothers, sister, etc.

(3) Does the Panguitch city has relatives in the entity ? Yes or no. ----- keep this in documentation for further due process.

The city can lie down the road, if verbal communication is in process.

Then it gets very messy.

(4) If no, there is no case.

(5) If yes, state law puts burden on the government entity (Panguitch City) to have total population of less than 3,000 in 40 mile radius.

(6) If yes and no compliance - fine to the city per day of violation.

In this tight monogamous community - it is difficult to do find simple things.
