HISTORY and FACTS

On August 29, 2018, I duly furnished to the certified Records Officer of the Utah Local Governments' Trust (ULGT) named Brady Loveland a request to access and inspect certain bonds acquired and filed by those persons elected or appointed as certain public officers of the ULGT. I forward you such request.

On September 10, 2018, Brady transmitted to me via the United States Postal Service an initial decision made with respect to my request by a person named "A. Craig Hale". (attached) Such person is not a certified Records Officer, board member, staff officer or any other officer or employee of the ULGT. Therefore, I consider such decision to be illegal and void.

On September 18, 2018, I appealed to the Chief Executive Officer of the ULGT to make a decision with respect to Brady constructively denying my access to and inspection of the public officers' bonds referred to above. I forward you such appeal.

As of today, Steve has neglected to make an appellate decision with respect to my request.

I hereby appeal to the SRC to conduct a hearing with respect to my being denied access to and inspection of the public officers' bonds referred to above.
