HISTORY & FACTS

As of September 26, 2018, the Clerk/Auditor of the WCC named Ricky Hatch (Ricky) has never been recognized as a certified Records Officer. (See <https://axaemarchives.utah.gov/public/CountyAgencies.pdf>)

On September 26, 2018, I furnished to the Clerk/Auditor/Records Officer of the WCC named Ricky Hatch (Ricky) a request to access and inspect the digitized copies of the public official penal bonds and constitutional oaths of certain elected and appointed officers of the WCC. (attached)

On October 21, 2018, Ricky was still not recognized as a certified Records Officer of the WCC. (See <https://axaemarchives.utah.gov/public/CountyAgencies.pdf>)

On October 22, 2018, I was served notice of an initial decision made by Ricky that implies I shall I have to pay fees to access such bonds and oaths.

WCC Code Title 2-Chapter 13 does provide a fee schedule with respect to accessing and inspecting public records.

As of October 22, 2018, the website of the WCC did not provide documentation of the identity of the "agency designee" or of the "chief administrative officer for appeals" who are both referred to under WCC Code 2-13-7. (<http://www.webercountyutah.gov/Transparency/grama.php>)

On October 22, 2018 and in accordance with UC 63G-2-401(1), I appealed to the three commissioners of the WCC named James Harvey, James Ebert and Scott Jenkins (collectively, Commissioners) that Ricky was not certified and that I had been constructively denied such bonds and oaths. (attached)

As of today, Ricky is still not recognized as a certified records officer of the WCC. (See <https://axaemarchives.utah.gov/public/CountyAgencies.pdf>)

BASIS

I consider any action taken by Ricky with respect to my request to be invalid and non-governing.
