Dear Ms. Dubovik:

Thank you for your kind response regarding my appeal about the abuse and denial of any medication to my sister, This took place at the hands of her son, of

a family friend first reported this inhumane treatment of my sister, to the Department of Elder Abuse on or about March 21, 2015. I reported it on or about the following day. I spoke on the phone at length to (Elder Abuse Representative for State of UT) two different times, outlining the atrocious treatment of my sister. After that, I left word several times for to return my call since I heard no progress report from him.

I finally talked to who identified herself as supervisor, on July 23, 2015. She simply said, "The case is closed".

I ask that you read the details of my description of how her son, abused especially with regard to denying her pain medication that she had routinely been taking before she fell and broke three bones, femur, hip and shoulder. She begged him for her life night after night during March. During the month of March, fired the nurse and and ordered me to leave and return to Kansas City where I live.

At that time, he told me that he would not let life interfere with his business, nor would he get up at night to tend to her cries for help.

I don't know what happened the last night of her life because her had visited that day and had spoken and prayed with claims to have found her dead the next morning when he got up.

Even though I was not her "legal guardian" I made numerous trips to care for for ten+ years. I stayed with her for weeks at a time and cared for her; she was like a mother to me. I am asking for a review of this case. I want to know what action was taken, by whom, to investigate how my sister was treated during her final days. I believe the overall treatment by her son during the month of March 2015 was criminal and inhumane.

In the next emails, I am sending copies of correspondence I have had with the State of Utah. Thank you for your reply and assistance.
