Pursuant to Utah Code Sec. 63G-2-403(2) as the Appellant shown above, hereby files this appeal to the State Records Committee (otherwise "SRC"). Attached are relevant documents herein, giving rise to this judicial review ("Appeal") notice to due to his total of three denials, having deprived not only himself, but the Salt Lake City region (otherwise "Community") whereby faulty claims of secrecy are suspected, not only prejudicing this party, but the Community at large as it's notably in the public interest.

BACKGROUND FACTS

- 1) On Feb. 27, 2016, a Kenyan born, refugee juvenile was shot by two officers of the Salt Lake City Police Dept. ("SLCPD") 3-4 times resulting in permanent injury to him.

- 2) He was on the public record since that date as a juvenile, and under Utah, his identity could not be released, but was given to the media by witnesses. But, officially the city couldn't release it.
- 3) Suspect's name was mentioned by witnesses as _____ His name was given to media before his 18th birthday while remained "in custody" of police, even as lay in an area hospital after critically wounded as such.
- 4) Appellant files GRAMA request sought [see Exhibit A]
- 5) May 12, 2016, civil liberties advocates, ACLU of Ut. Appeals to city and County for answers for among other things: Incident Reports, Police Body Camera footage, etc.
- 6) The reason he was shot and nearly killed, remains under investigation from the date of said shooting, until Aug. 5, 2016, nearly five mos., from _____ date of harm.
- 7) Outcry of the Community began the time of the shooting by a resistance after the two officers' having shot the youth; with a "riot" ensuing in the vicinity of 245 Rio Grande, in S. L. City, downtown outside a nearby homeless shelter.
- 8) Protesters two days later took to streets downtown, in the interest of seeking justice.
- 9) Aug. 5, 2016, County District Atty. Simarjit "Sim" Gill releases full names of officers involved in the shooting and gives other names, even initials of victims, that went into evidence according to Gill's public statement.
- 10) Aug. 8, 2016 Gill announced before media, and in news releases that _____ would receive felony charges- thus _____ was charged with aggravated assault and possession of a controlled substances at that time.

RELIEF SOUGHT

Gill's long drawn out statement put out on August 5th reveals more than the police report [see Exhibit B] which long after the initial investigation- that took place, nearly six month isn't enough, for the public interest.

Appellant as a social justice advocate- assists organizers in the Community and involved with a group called "Dissenters for Justice" revokes not relaying public event on public property can not be effectively used pursuant to we object to the police report as insufficient without a body camera video and audio showing and describing those actions written by Gill that he put out on Aug. 5th. Hence, having conveniently classified all and any **police body camera footage**-on Feb. 27, 2016 from background information- doesn't suffice given the nature of "evidence" already since shared by Gill publicly, as Protected records also pursuant to 63G-2-305(10) both (a) and (c) and raised in denials on the specific shooting of _____ will not deprive anyone a fair trial or interfere with any claimed "investigatin- charges have been filed. Request for such record should be granted as such.

We have not included any non-public information in this document.

We declare under penalty of Utah Code Section 78B-5-705 that everything stated in this document is true.
