RE: DCFS Decision regarding GRAMA Request / Case Number 2447548 and/or 2446067

State Records Committee / Ms. Gina Proctor:

This letter is in response to the letter sent to me by Sonia Sweeney that was dated February 4th, 2019. Thank you for your cooperative decision to send a partially redacted copy of case number 2446067 as stated in Ms. Sweeney's letter. However, the change of the DCFS supported finding is regarding case number 2447548 as stated in Ms. Jaime Graham's letter of January 3, 2019. Therefore, the first thing that needs to be clarified is why this case seems to have two different case numbers.

I am concerned the essential information that is needed will be redacted from what you are willing to send me. Therefore, I am sending this request to the State Records Committee and copying others involved asking them for the information that is actually needed as explained below.

As I have stated before in a letter of appeal, in September of 2018, Joshua Paul Rosenhoover was supported by DCFS in their finding that he had committed severe sexual abuse against our minor son, [REDACTED]. However, on January 3, 2019, almost four months later, after I had put in my first GRAMA request, DCFS sent a letter to [REDACTED] stating that DCFS decided to change the supported finding to unsupported in the DCFS system so the original finding regarding case number 2447548 will not be found in the Licensing Information System. This statement indicates that removing the supported finding has much to do with helping Joshua Rosenhoover keep a negative entry off his commercial pilot's license and has very little to do with protecting our son from further sexual abuse. This is very concerning.

I believe that you and the police departments may have been persuaded by false information and input regarding this case and that is why I need to receive an un-redacted copy of the file that states exactly why this case was changed from supported to unsupported. I need to know what persuaded DCFS to change their finding and put our son in danger of severe sexual abuse again. According to our son's therapist, our son is not ready to reenter a relationship with his dad at this time before he finishes his ongoing extensive psychological therapy and before a workable safety plan can be put in place regarding parent time with his dad.

Thank you for your help and consideration regarding this matter.
