I am filing this Notice of Appeal on behalf of my client, Ai Ning Hsu. On September 4, 2019 and September 10, 2019, my clients received letters from the DHS Chief Administrative Officer requiring DCFS to provide to Ms. Hsu less redacted versions of records previously provided to her. Ms. Hsu, in turn, was provided a second version of DCFS PSS Activity records on September 13, 2019 and a second version of DCFS text communication records on September 24, 2019. Upon reviewing the documents, Ms. Hsu is submitting this Notice of Appeal. These records are in response to Ms. Hsu's initial GRAMA Request she submitted June 10, 2019. DCFS has yet to provide Ms. Hsu the balance of the email communication records that were withheld that DCFS has informed her will be provided by November 13, 2019.

Ms. HSU continues to seek the complete records requested on June 10, 2019.
