I appeal the Attorney General Office's response to record request #15-138 based on the following grounds:

a. The requested records do not contain "personal status information", as defined in U.C.A. 63G-2-302(2)(a). None of the information in the Human Resource Enterprise database under the Service tab is defined as private.

b. The identities and job descriptions of the SECUR Task Force members listed in Request #15-138 are well documented in the public domain, including in federal grants which claim Task Force members would use a "community involvement strategy" to establish rapport with community leaders, not operating "undercover" as defined by law.
